How much does a Bess cost?

The cost of a BESS (Battery Energy Storage System) has declined significantly. For a BESS of the same capacity, engineering, procurement and construction (EPC) costs have declined from approximately \$278/kWh in 2012 to \$70/kWh.

How will a new battery energy storage system benefit New Zealand?

The BESS will help integrate growing shares of renewable energy from variable wind and solar PV generation, while also providing fast reserve ancillary services to the grid. WEL Networks and Infratec said they are actively pursuing other opportunities to enhance resilience and increase access to renewable energy in the region.

In 2024, wholesale electricity prices spiked from roughly \$300/MWh to over \$800/MWh due to a combination of low hydro storage, high gas prices, and low wind generation. This volatility underscores the importance of integrating more BESS to stabilize the grid and manage energy supply more effectively.
