Where does bboxx install solar panels?

Bboxx installs a solar panel which can power up to five lights, a television, radio, torch or a 12 V battery.

In July 2017 Bboxx announced plans to install 300,000 solar home systems in Togo after winning approval from president Faure Gnassingbe and three months later the company announced a \$5 million credit line from Deutsche Asset Management.
