Kosovo has announced the winner of its first solar power tender, with a consortium led by Swiss construction group Orllati securing a 100-MW project with a bid of EUR 48.88 per MWh. The competition attracted six bidders, but only five participated in the e-auction, including companies from Turkey, France, and Egypt.

The EIB is providing EUR33 million for the construction of one of Kosovo's largest solar photovoltaic plants. In line with the EU Global Gateway initiative, the project will also benefit from a EUR29 million loan from the KfW Development Bank and a EUR32 million EU grant channelled through the Western Balkans Investment Framework

The government of Kosovo has announced the names of six bidders that have made applications for a contract to construct a new 100MW solar plant in the country.

A 2021 USAID market study indicated a potential pipeline of small-scale solar projects for upwards of 250 MW by 2030. By highlighting rooftop solar and identifying installation opportunities with a good return on investment, USAID is catalyzing private sector contributions to easing Kosovo's acute energy shortage.
