

French energy minister Ségolène Royal has signed a decree establishing an energy programme (PPE) for French Guiana, that aims to use solar, biomass and hydro to reach 85% renewables generation ...

HDF Energy's Renewable solution combines a 55 MW solar farm with what the company says is the world's largest renewable energy storage solution, to provide a ground-breaking 140 MWh capacity, based on hydrogen for use in a fuel cell system.

In French Guiana, a region with high annual sunshine hours, the Group operates two photovoltaic power plants, Matoury and Kourou, located in areas free from conflicts of use. The larger of the two - and indeed the largest anywhere in Overseas France - is located in Kourou.

French renewable power producer Voltalia SA (EPA:VL TSA) has started the construction works on a 5-MW solar farm combined with a 10.6-MWh lithium-ion battery storage unit in French Guiana. Named Sable Blanc, the photovoltaic (PV) plant should be able to generate 7,430 MWh annually, enough to meet the electrical demands of 3,090 people in Western ...

Renewable power plants operator Voltalia SA (EPA:VL TSA) on Thursday announced the commissioning of its 5-MW Parc Sable Blanc solar farm with an integrated storage system in French Guiana. The Paris-based company secured the project in a government tender for solar projects in non-interconnected zones (ZNIs) in May 2021.

French Western Guiana Solar PV Park is a 55MW solar PV power project. It is planned in Saint-Laurent-du-Maroni, French Guiana. According to GlobalData, who tracks and profiles over 170,000 power plants worldwide, the project is currently at the under construction stage.

The installation will also bring EDF closer to its Solar Plan's objectives of making it one of France's leading players of solar energy with a 30% market share by 2035. The Toucan 2 photovoltaic power plant, which is located in the French Guiana municipality of Montsinéry-Tonnegrande, boasts abundant solar irradiation at the near-5 ...
