How many liters can a bladder hold?

While extremely rare, it is physically possible for a bladder to hold up to 2 liters in certain circumstances: Urinary retention - Inability to fully empty the bladder can gradually allow larger volumes of urine to accumulate. Bladder training - Progressively holding more urine over time can expand bladder capacity.

How long does it take a bladder to poop?

An average adult bladder can hold between one and two cups, and it typically takes nine to 10 hours to produce that much urine. If you hold your pee for longer than that, your bladder can go into a state of urinary retention, meaning you cannot pee even if you try. Eventually, a backup of urine could cause these serious side effects.

What happens when the bladder reaches its limits?

When the bladder reaches its limits, it signals the need to urinate. The brain then sends signals to relax the sphincter and contract the detrusor to expel urine through the urethra. The average adult bladder can hold between 400-600 mL of urine at a time.

How many ml can a person hold in a Pee?
