Will Iran add 500MW of solar power by next year?

By bne Tehran bureau Iran plans to add 500MWof solar power capacity by the end of the current Iranian year,as part of a broader initiative to expand its renewable energy infrastructure by more than 4,000MW by next year,Energy Minister Abbas Aliabadi announced on December 20.

How much solar power does Iran have?

Iran's existing solar capacity stands at 1,200MW,but the planned expansion could push that figure to between 3,000 and 4,000MW by next year,marking a substantial increase in the country's renewable energy portfolio.

How much sunlight does Iran get a year?

Iran receives more than 300 sunny daysper year with solar radiation averaging 2,200 kilowatt-hours per square metre annually,making it one of the region's most promising markets for solar energy development. More than two-thirds of the country's territory receives enough sunlight to support utility-scale solar installations.

How much solar power does India have?

More than two-thirds of the country's territory receives enough sunlight to support utility-scale solar installations. The country's power grid,which generates approximately 350bn kWh annually,has the technical capacity to integrate up to 30,000MWof solar power,Aliabadi told state news agency Mehr.

A 1.8GW solar panel production line will soon be inaugurated, increasing annual production capacity to 2.3GW.

The Prime Minister had launched the scheme on 13th February, 2024. The major highlights of the scheme include: Central Financial Assistance (CFA) for Residential Rooftop Solar. The scheme provides a CFA of 60% of system cost for 2 kW systems and 40% of additional system cost for systems between 2 to 3 kW capacity. The CFA will be capped at 3 kW.

In a report by the English news site in Iran Press TV, rooftop solar units in the country will expand quickly to over 100,000 in the calendar year to March 2023, and the rooftop panels will have a maximum electricity ...
