

What is the difference between a G and a J?

The great majority of Germanic languages, such as German, Dutch, Icelandic, Swedish, Danish and Norwegian, use <j> for the palatal approximant /j /, which is usually represented by the letter <y> in English. Other than English, notable exceptions are Scots, where it represents /dʒ /, and Luxembourgish, where it represents both /j / and /ʃ /.
