The project is the first IPP in Mozambique to integrate a utility scale energy storage system and includes an upgrade to the existing Cuamba substation. Electricity will be sold through a 25-year power purchase agreement with EDM.

The Metoro Solar Power Station is a 41 megawatts solar power plant in Mozambique. The power station was developed by a consortium comprising Neoen, a French independent power producer (IPP), based in Paris, France and Electricidade de Moçambique (EDM), the Mozambican electricity utility company. Construction began in October 2020, with commercial commissioning expected in the fourth quarter of 2021.

Central Solar de Mocuba has increased Mozambique's energy generation capacity by 40 MW and will produce approximately 79 GWh per year. The project's strategic location will reduce energy transmission losses and improve the security of energy supply in northern Mozambique and stabilize the grid.
