What is a solar farm? A solar farm is a large collection of solar panels that absorb energy from the sun. The energy that is absorbed by the panels is transferred into the national power grid, which distributes electricity to homes and businesses across Aotearoa New Zealand.

Where is New Zealand's largest solar power farm?

Kapanu Solar Farm - Image Source: Sunergise In operation since May 2021, New Zealand's largest solar power farm is in Kapuni, Taranaki. The solar capacity of the solar farm is 2.1MW, comprising 5,800 solar panels. The solar power plant will generate enough electricity to power over 520 homes.

Will New Zealand's solar farms feed into the power grid?

These first solar farms, and the ones across New Zealand that follow, will feed into the power grid and then into thousands of homes and businesses across Aotearoa. How many solar panels can a New Zealand solar farm produce?
