What is the energy transition in Poland?

Wholesale energy prices in Poland compared to other EU countries remain very high, and the economy's dependence on imported fossil fuels is growing rapidly. In the latest, seventh edition of the "Energy Transition in Poland" report, Forum Energii presents the state of transition play and a broader look at the overall process.

How much power does Poland have?

Poland's 42 GW capacity electrical power generation system is the largest in Central and Eastern Europe. Almost eighty percent of Poland's electricity is produced by hard and brown coal fired power plants that primarily are powered by Polish coal.

What percentage of Poland's electricity is produced by coal?

Almost eighty percent of Poland's electricity is produced by hard and brown coal fired power plants that primarily are powered by Polish coal. The bulk of Poland's coal-fired power plants were built between 1960-1980, and now they are worn-out and don't meet the EU's strict environmental requirements for greenhouse gas emissions reduction.

Why is energy production increasing in Poland?

At the same time, energy production from natural gas increased, by more than 40%. This is a result of falling fuel prices and the flexibility of gas generation. Wholesale energy prices in Poland compared to other EU countries remain very high, and the economy's dependence on imported fossil fuels is growing rapidly.

How many hydroelectric power plants are there in Poland?

Poland currently has 786 hydroelectric power plants, the vast majority of which (705) are relatively small, generating no more than 1 MW. Many of the smaller power plants are privately owned by small firms and family businesses, with the bigger ones owned by major electricity producers or the state.

Does Poland have a helmsman for the energy transition?

The energy transition in Poland has no helmsman. There is no single centre to manage the process, so the changes taking place are chaotic. Poland has never offered a comprehensive vision for the decarbonisation of the economy or a plan to reduce dependence on energy resources imported from abroad.
