

The Government of Tonga has formulated targets to transform its energy sector by achieving a 50 percent share of renewables in the country's energy generation mix by 2020 and 70 percent by 2030. However, achieving these targets require catalytic investments to transform the country's energy infrastructure.

The project, titled "Improving Grid Operation under the Centralized Control Centre," will significantly strengthen the Kingdom of Tonga's renewable energy infrastructure, promoting sustainability and energy security.

French renewable power producer Akuo Energy said Friday it has secured a contract to build in Tonga an energy storage system with a capacity of 23.4 MWh/6 MW. The company will be in charge of the engineering, procurement and construction (EPC) of the Tonga 2 facility under a contract signed in November with grid operator Tonga Power Ltd.
