Grupo Cobra, part of Spanish builder ACS (BME:ACS), has emerged as the largest winner in Spain's latest renewables auction, as it has been awarded 1,550 MW of solar photovoltaic (PV) capacity, Reuters reports.

The projects are located in four Spanish provinces--Huelva, Albacete, Ciudad Real and Toledo--bringing the IPP's operational capacity in Spain to over 400MW across 12 projects.

Recent examples include Lightsource BP, which earlier this year agreed to sell its solar PV portfolio in Spain to Spanish fund manager Plenium Partners. In March, the solar developer also said it has obtained clearance to build solar PV plants across Spain with a capacity of more than 1.6 GW and requiring an investment of more than EUR 1.2bn.
