Where is St Lucia's first solar PV plant located?

On the 11th April 2018, the St. Lucia Electricity Services Limited (LUCELEC) - the sole electric utility company on the island - completed the commissioning of the island's first utility-scale solar PV plant. The plant is rated at 3 megawatt (MW) and is located in La Tourney, Vieux Fort, just north of the Hewanorra International Airport.

How much does electricity cost in Saint Lucia?

The 2015 electricity rates in Saint Lucia are \$0.34 per kilowatt-hour (kWh), in line with the Caribbean regional average of \$0.33/kWh. Like many island nations, Saint Lucia is almost 100% reliant on imported fossil fuels for electricity generation, leaving it vulnerable to global oil price fluctuations that directly impact the cost of electricity.

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The \$20M solar farm is historic for Saint Lucia as it will be the first utility-scale renewable energy project on the island. It will be funded, owned and operated by LUCELEC. When completed in April 2018, it will have about 15 thousand panels and will generate 7 million kWhs (or units) of electricity per year.
