Who owns Trinidad and Tobago Electric Company?

The Trinidad and Tobago Electric Company Limited was bought by a Canadian businessman in 1901. The company later came into being as the Trinidad and Tobago Electricity Commission (T&TEC) by virtue of the T&TEC Ordinance No. 42 of 1945.

How is electricity produced in Trinidad and Tobago?

In Trinidad and Tobago (T&T), electricity is primarily produced by burning natural gas. The heat energy released is used to produce steam. This steam is then used to turn a steam turbine which is connected to an electrical generator to produce electricity.

Who owns the power generation company of Trinidad and Tobago?

The Power Generation Company of Trinidad and Tobago (PowerGen) was established on December 23rd, 1994. Ownership of this new entity consisted of a government shareholding via T&TEC of 51% in the company and a divestment of the remaining 49% of its shareholding to Atlanta - based Southern Electric International and AMOCO Energy Resources.

Who owns Maruenergy Trinidad?

Today, the shareholders in the Company are the Trinidad and Tobago Electricity Commission with a 51% shareholding, MaruEnergy Trinidad LLC (owned by Japanese multinational - Marubeni) with a 39% shareholding and NEL Power Holdings Limited with a 10% ownership.

Who produces power in Trinidad & Tobago?

These producers are the Power Generation Company of Trinidad and Tobago (PowerGen) giving a total of 1,344 MW, Trinidad Generation Unlimited (TGU) giving 720 MW and Trinity Power Ltd. giving 225 MW. All power stations in Trinidad and Tobago are fueled by hydrocarbons. T&TEC was formed in 1946 after the merger of independent companies.
